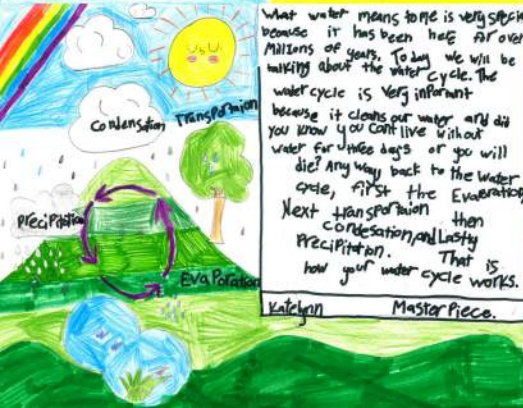
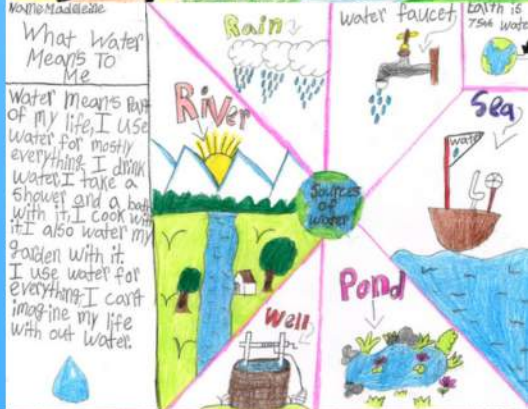
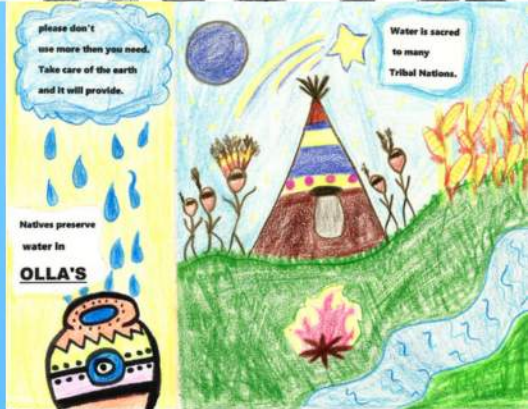

CONSERVATION TIP #2 - KEEP A PITCHER IN THE FRIDGE: INSTEAD OF RUNNING THE TAP, KEEP A PITCHER OF DRINKING WATER IN THE REFRIGERATOR.

CONSERVATION TIP #2 - KEEP SOIL HEALTHY: SOIL HEALTH CAN INFLUENCE WATER RETENTION AND DRAINAGE. HEALTHY SOIL AIDS IN WATER STORAGE, DECREASES EVAPORATION, AND HELPS ROOT GROWTH.
